# Eureka Secondary School Kells County Meath School Self Evaluation (S.S.E.) School Community Report August 2016

The focus of SSE in Eureka is to improve student outcomes in both areas through student engagement and teacher practice.

The following is a brief summary of our achievements to date in meeting both our Literacy and Numeracy Targets, as stated in our *School Improvement Plan*. <sup>1</sup>

# Literacy Targets [2013 – 2016] – How are we doing? <sup>2</sup>

TARGET	To improve student confidence levels in contributing to class discussions without teacher prompting.
RESULTS TO DATE (June 2016)	95% of Students Surveyed (May 2016) were confident either some or all of the time. (Target as per S.I.P. was 40%)

TARGET	Strategies should be introduced to improve student proficiency in spelling and grammar.
RESULTS TO DATE (June 2016)	77% of Students Surveyed (May 2016) responded that their spelling and grammatical use of Key Words have improved through the Key Words Strategy.

TARGET	Keyboard skills of students should be improved.
RESULTS TO DATE (June 2016)	88% of Students surveyed (May 2016) agreed or somewhat agreed that their Digital Literacy (Keyboarding) skills have improved.

# Numeracy Targets [2014-2017]— How are we doing?

TARGET	To improve both the use/understanding of mathematical language, estimation skills in converting fractions to percentages, converting fractions to percentages using a calculator and 'rounding off' decimals to the nearest whole number.
RESULTS TO DATE (June 2016)	77% of Students surveyed (May 2016) agreed or somewhat agreed that they are more confident in converting Fractions to Percentages as a result of completing Numeracy Sheets.

TARGET	To ensure a more consistent approach to the teaching of Numeracy throughout the whole school community.
RESULTS TO DATE (June 2016)	83% of Students surveyed (May 2016) stated that they were more confident in completed Bar Charts as a result of completing Numeracy Sheets.

## **LITERACY ACTIONS 2016/17**

- Integrate Key Words into everyday classwork WEEKLY SCHOOL KEYWORDS.
- Literacy Targets to extend to 1<sup>st</sup>; 2<sup>nd</sup>; Junior Cert. and Transition Years.
- 2016/17 School Journal to include dedicated Key Words Pages for each Subject.

## **NUMERACY ACTIONS 2016/17**

- Numeracy Sheets (including Bar Charts) to be included in each Years' Journal and will replace the Numeracy Folders used to date.
- Numeracy Targets to extend to  $1^{st}$ ;  $2^{nd}$  and Junior Certificate Classes.

### ASSESSMENT FOR LEARNING (A.F.L.) ACTIONS 2016/17

- Numeracy Pages will include Bar Charts to be completed by each student to help their understanding of areas they are doing well in/need to be improved.
- 2016/17 School Journal to include a dedicated A.F.L. page where each student provides answers to the following questions <u>on a weekly basis:</u>

What did I do well during the week?
What could have I done better during the week?
What next? What do I have to do to improve?
