Leaving Certificate Established (LCE)

The established Leaving Certificate is a **two-year** programme where students typically study **seven subjects**, three of these being the core subjects of **English**, **Irish & Maths**.

Students can opt to study these subjects at either <u>Higher Level</u> or <u>Ordinary Level</u>, while <u>Foundation Level</u> can be chosen in both **Irish & Maths**.


